

LRS Federal Project Description

UST Removal

With little more than a 2-page facsimile outlining the requirements, LRS was able to devise a technical approach and cost proposal that resulted in the award of a contract by the Naval Research Laboratory (NRL) in Washington DC to remove a 2000-gallon underground storage tank (UST), an oil-water separator and a grease trap.

The UST and associated structures were sandwiched between two active maintenance



facilities which presented a considerable challenge for accomplishing the removals without damaging the adjacent structures. Following removal of the structures, the area was paved with concrete to maintain the functional use of the facilities. After careful planning and coordination with site personnel, we performed the necessary engineering and construction planning to mobilize



the construction equipment, roll-off bins and personnel to accomplish all of the work safely and within the tight schedule required by the NRL.

This successful project resulted in a followup contract to remove two additional 4,000-gallon USTs at another location on the NRL property.
