

LRS Federal Project Description

UST Removal

LRS Federal provided on-site support and management for the removal and proper disposal of three 8,000 gallon steel underground storage tanks (UST) for a former bank branch located in Altus, Oklahoma.

Activities performed under this contract include:

 Obtaining all necessary permits and providing notifications required from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (OCC) and preparing the Site Specific Health & Safety Plan.



- Pumping and disposal of residual liquids from three 8,000 gallon USTs
- Excavation and stockpiling of overburden soils.
- Removal and disposal of three 8,000 gallon USTs. Each tank was removed individually. As one tank was removed the excavation area was backfilled and excavation of the next tank began until all three tanks were removed. Dry ice was placed in each tank to displace oxygen and create inert conditions. Removal activities were performed under the supervision and guidance of an OCC certified UST remover.
- Obtaining confirmatory samples from the stockpiled soil and side walls and bottom floor of the UST excavation area. Sampling activities were performed under the supervision and guidance of an OCC certified UST remover.
- Removal of portion of the product line and capping of the portion remaining in place. The layout of the product line was unknown; therefore, the product line was traced (involved cutting concrete and excavating soil) and determined to extend beneath the former bank branch. All remaining fuel was containerized and the product line capped.
- Restoring work area to existing conditions to match existing grades of the surrounding area. All excavations were backfilled with soil. Rebar was placed above the soil in all excavated areas and concrete was later poured to match existing grades.
- Preparing the Final Closure Report for submittal to the FDIC and OCC. The Final Closure Report was accepted and approved by the FDIC and OCC with no further action required.
