

LRS Federal Project Description

Green Basing/Procurement, Marine Corps Logistics Base Barstow, CA

LRS Federal supported Marine Corps Logistics Base (MCLB) Barstow with implementing green basing. The USMC selected MCLB Barstow as a pilot installation and LRS Federal performed process mapping and provided improvement recommendations for all major processes that introduced materials onto the installation. The result of this effort improved supply, contracting, and construction practices in meeting green procurement objectives. LRS Federal developed recommendations for process improvement and mechanisms for capturing data within an overall Green Base Tracking System.





Green Procurement

LRS Federal also supported the MCLB Barstow "Green Procurement" program with development of the initial Green Procurement Process Analysis which mapped first level organizational responsibilities (e.g. environmental, procurement, hazardous materials pharmacy, etc.) The result defined management responsibilities and how a systems-based approach is best utilized to assist tracking, managing, and reporting progress in implementation of Green Procurement.
